MISSION

Be Formed is a 90-day discipleship experience for men and women that includes weekly videos, small groups, prayer, fellowship and nights of reflection. Through Be Formed, individuals are given the opportunity to pray and listen to the spiritual, pastoral, human and intellectual commitments the Lord is calling them to focus on.

What does a Be Formed Small Group look like?

A Be Formed Small Group is a group of men, women, couples or a mixed group of men and women who wish to deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ through continued formation and fellowship with others. Small groups meet weekly as a group, and are invited to attend other large group gatherings throught the year. The content includes topics such as Prayer, Scripture, the Sacraments, and the Teachings and Traditions of the Catholic Church. Be Formed is open to anyone at any point on their journey and led by trained facilitators who guide the weekly meetings either in person or virtually. Within their small group, participants discuss blessings, what struck their heart at Mass, what resonated with them from the weekly content video and are encouraged to pray Lectio Divina together. Be Formed Small Groups establish and foster fellowship and Christian friendships which seek to strengthen individual's faith and relationship with God.

co-facilitators, whether it
be a couple or pair of men
or women who co-facilitate
together. When facilitators
have a partner to lean on,
the mission is strengthened,
supported and encouraged.

Having another participant along on the journey to be trained for facilitating the next season keeps future movement and growth in motion. It is recommended to have current facilitators guiding and training new facilitators during the duration of the season for the start-up of a new group for the following season.
